In particular, under the chairmanship of President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev on March 19, 2019 to strengthen attention to youth, attract the younger generation to culture, arts, physical culture and sports, develop skills in the proper use of information technology, promote reading among young people, ensure women's employment held a meeting on

At this meeting, the head of our state put forward five important initiatives to organize work in the social, spiritual and educational spheres on the basis of a new system. The first initiative serves to increase the interest of young people in music, painting, literature, theater and other types of art, to reveal their talents; the second initiative is aimed at creating the necessary conditions for physical training of young people, to demonstrate their abilities in sports; the third initiative is aimed at organizing the effective use of computer technology and the Internet among the population and youth; the fourth initiative is aimed at raising the morale of young people, the organization of systematic work to promote reading among them; the fifth initiative will focus on women's employment.

Today, the peoples of the world are making serious efforts to study and promote their national culture and spirituality, to preserve and develop their rich traditions, to establish creative cooperation, to organize international festivals, scientific and practical conferences, and to conduct research. The role of UNESCO in this is great, and at the initiative of this organization, serious attention is paid to the study of intangible, spiritual and cultural heritage.

On June 12, 2019, the Youth Center in Bukhara hosted a youth festival under the motto "Five initiatives, five wings", organized as part of the "Youth Month". The festival is organized in collaboration with the Bukhara Regional Department of Culture, Bukhara Waves Dance Ensemble, Bukhara Regional Branch of the Composers' Union, the Regional Council of the Youth Union of Uzbekistan, Bukhara Regional Branch. is of particular importance.

Also, the work carried out in the framework of the third of these five important initiatives put forward by the President, "Organization of effective use of computer technology and the Internet among the population and youth," is being effectively implemented in all regions of the country.

In particular, the Ministry of Information Technologies and Communications has been instructed to establish "Digital Technology Training Centers" in all city and district centers on the basis of international best practices, free training in e-commerce and programming, innovative skills in entrepreneurship in information technology. priority issues such as

In order to effectively organize the work in this area, a concept for the establishment of such centers in all districts and cities of Syrdarya region has been developed.

On March 22, 2019, the Digital Technology Center was opened in the administrative building of the Mirzaabad district telecommunication link of the Syrdarya regional branch of Uzbektelecom JSC.

The center, located in Mirzaabad district, will serve as a bridge between other centers in the cities and districts of Syrdarya region and the Tashkent University of Information Technologies named after Muhammad al-Khwarizmi, Inha University in Tashkent and the Technopark based on the best practices of India.

The center organizes training courses for young people in the field of information technology, programming, robotics, basics of e-sports and innovative entrepreneurship in e-commerce, in which students in 3 age groups, ie 9-15, 16-19 and 20-25 years, gradually learn information and communication technologies. trained as future professionals in the field.

In addition, the center provides for the involvement of young people in computer sports (e-sports), training in the rules of e-sports, the formation of teams in various games, the organization of team games, competitions throughout the country. helps.

The opening ceremony of the Center for Digital Technologies was attended by representatives of state and public organizations, educational institutions, experts in the field.

Similar experiments have been introduced in Boka district of Tashkent region. As a result of these experiments, the conditions for quality education of young people in Boka district will be completely changed.

This can be seen in the third initiative of the Ministry of Information Technologies and Communications - "Effective use of computer technology and the Internet among the population and youth."

Construction and repair work was carried out in the center of Boka district on the area of 130 sq.m.

The training center will provide young people aged 14 to 30 with innovative skills in entrepreneurship in the field of information technology, as well as free training in the basics of information technology, e-commerce, programming and e-sports, and more than 430 young people in short and long-term training courses.

In particular, 328.5 km to provide high-speed Internet services to 49 schools, 14 preschools, 10 health facilities in the district. construction of fiber-optic communication lines.

Also, in accordance with the Action Strategy for the five priority areas of development of the Republic of Uzbekistan for 2017-2021 and the Concept of Administrative Reform in the Republic of Uzbekistan: higher and secondary special, modern and independent thinking in the field of vocational education, high spiritual and moral qualities, educated and highly qualified personnel training, raising the educational process to a qualitatively new level and the introduction of advanced forms of teaching, information and communication technologies; issues such as strengthening the spiritual and moral content of education, the organization of educational work in the spirit of patriotism on the basis of humanism and high spiritual ideas, respect for national values, devotion to the ideas of independence, youth.
