- It is not allowed to include elements of the State Flag, State Emblem of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the details of documents or advertising materials of non-governmental organizations. Designations representing the image of the State Flag, the State Emblem of the Republic of Uzbekistan cannot be used for commercial purposes to promote produced or sold goods (works, services).
- Symbols of non-governmental non-profit organizations cannot be similar to the State Flag, State Emblem of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
